The grade 3 Classroom

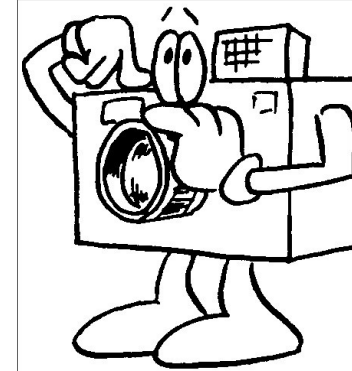
