Our 1st team Rugby boys have won 20 games and only lost one. The boys have worked very hard and have combined well.

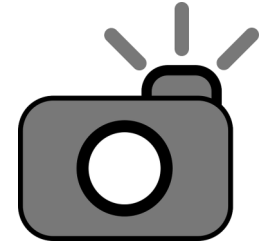
