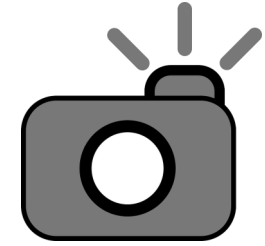
He looks forward to working with the little ones and sharing the skills that he learnt at the Seminar.
