The grade 1 and 2 boys have been winning the bulk of their games.

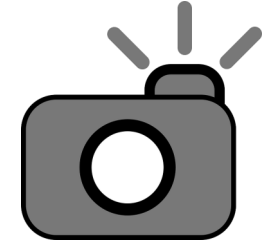
We recently had our Inter-School Athletics afternoon with Clarendon, Northern Park and Epworth. We came 3rd.
